Lewis Brothers has served the communities in Bucks, Lehigh, and Northampton counties for nine decades. "We're located in Quakertown, but a large part of our business covers the Lehigh Valley area," Irick said. "We are general contractors and builders with an expertise in developing custom residential and commercial projects."

Herbert and Harry Lewis, the founding partners of the company, built their brand as quality craftsmen within Quakertown's local community focusing on residential

projects. Years later, with the addition of the Millwork Shop, Lewis Brothers was able to expand their customer base. By offering in-house, custom-made cabinetry and moldings, the company was able to establish a prominent reputation of building and renovating several area churches, as well as other historical town structures. In the early 2000s, the company began focusing on a mix of residential and commercial work and has since gained traction with large-scale custom home and remodeling projects.

"Currently, we're still holding that trend of business, but we also do handyman services for our existing clients. If your roof is leaking or a piece of siding blew off your house, we'll do the repairs," Irick explained. "We enjoy developing our customer's vision and adding our unique and personal touch to each project. Our superior level of service has helped Lewis Brothers gain new customers while retaining our long-standing customers."

Irick especially takes pride in his staff of 10 employees who are readied with a wide gamut of skills thanks to their longevity in the business. "Our staff are hardworking, professional carpenters who bring great value to both the company and its customers. Bruce Bauman has been working as a carpenter here for 43 years. We have a culture that makes our employees want to stay," said Irick, who has been at the company since graduating college in 2006.
